Good Hope Singers are a group of past members of the Good Hope School Choir who share the mission of serving our community while enjoying our singing. We recognize that we have been richly endowed by our Good Hope education. We also deeply appreciate the special gifts we have received through our choir training from our dedicated music teachers. We are the fruits of many years of labour of love at Good Hope School that can be better shared for the larger good of the Hong Kong community. Whatever little that we can do to help spread love and help the needy, we would want to do. We believe that with our passion in music directed at charitable works, we give a deeper meaning to our lives. Good Hope Singers Limited was therefore formed as a charitable organization on 23rd December, 2009 under the laws of Hong Kong.

Good hope School Choir was established in 1959 and has won top prizes for many years in the Hong Kong School Music festival, including The Best Girls' Choir and The Most Outstanding Choir of the Year. Over the years, the choir has the opportunity to sing under the baton of well-known musicians. The Choir has also made many overseas trips and helped build the international reputation of Good Hope School Choir and Hong Kong musicianship through participation in the Pan Pacific Music Camp in Australia, Pacific Basin Music Choral Competition in Hawaii, World Youth Day in the Philippines, Joliette Music Festival in Canada, Bela Bartok International Choir Competition in Hungary, to name a few.

Our Objectives

Formed under the auspices of our mother school and guided through the sponsorship efforts of Good Hope School Supervisor, Sr. Pauline Yuen, and Good Hope Primary School Principal, Sr. Lucia Leung, we are set to pursue the following objectives:

1. To promote and advance music education in Hong Kong at all levels;
2. To support the development of Hong Kong music talents;
3. To promote the Christian spirit of joy and thanksgiving and to share the love of God through music;
4. To raise funds through music activities and give donations to designated charitable organizations; and

Mission Statement

To help children of different abilities reach full potential in a happy and healthy environment,
thereby contributing to a more inclusive society

Established in 1963, Heep Hong Society is the largest service provider of early intervention and education for children with special needs in Hong Kong. Its Early Education and Training Centres and Special Child Care Centres provide pre-school education and training for children aged 0 – 6 with moderate to severe disabilities, including autistic spectrum disorders, developmental delay, sensory impairment, mental and physical handicap, behavior and learning problems. Heep Hong also operates Parents Resource Centres to support families with children from birth to junior high school suffering from developmental disorders. Altogether, Heep Hong serves over 6,000 families each year.

Music Therapy is one of the projects to be launched extensively in year 2011. Through rhythm games, music listening, singing, improvisation, instruments playing, taking turns to lead or to play, children can learn to interact with each other with the following skills being developed: 1) Visual-spatial awareness, analytical and mathematical mind, creativity; 2) Speech and verbal communication skills, social skills, self-esteem; 3) Perpetual-motor systems, including listening, sensitivity, timing; 4) Memory systems; 5) Musical and rhythmic skills.
